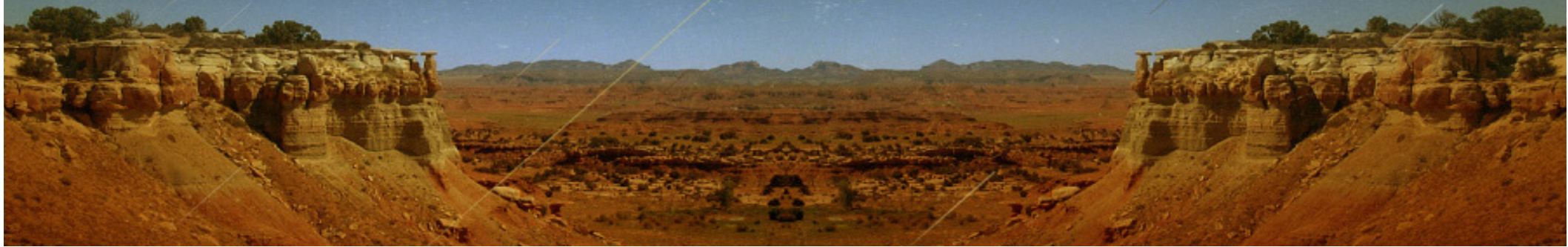

Rehearsals will be every Wed. starting June 6 at 6:30pm in the worship center. Presentation will be August 25 and 26.

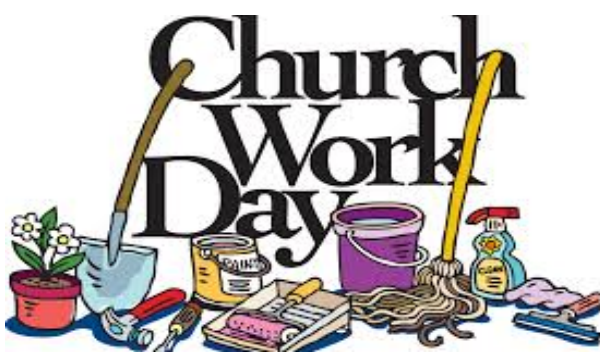
Children entering kindergarten through entering 6th grade this fall are welcome to participate. The cost is \$10 per child.



YOUNG ADULT ACTIVITIES

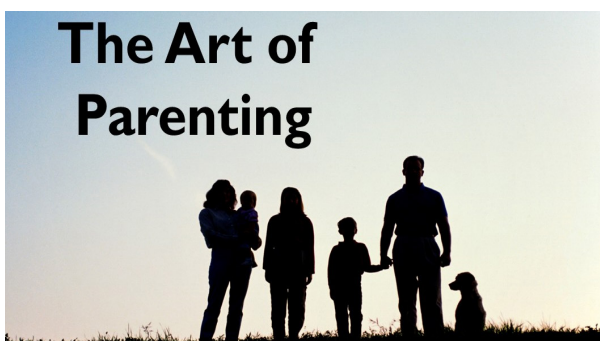
Route 415 starts June 6 from 6:30-8:00pm for 7th grade thru college-age students.
